NOTICE OF CALL FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST AFR/022 • 23 5606

Title: Formulation of project AFR/022: “Support to the African Union for the establishment and deployment of a continental Computer Security Incident Response Team (CSIRT)”

Maximum budget: 475 000 EUR - Performance period of six months

The Luxembourg Agency for development Cooperation (LuxDev) launches a CEOI for the acquisition of services for “Support to the African Union for the establishment and deployment of a continental Computer Security Incident Response Team (CSIRT)” on behalf of project AFR/022 receiving financial support from the government of the Grand-Duchy of Luxembourg.

Service providers that are invited to express their interest to offer the services mentioned above are:

All legally established companies governed by private law, non-governmental organisations, not-for-profit organisations and public operators specialised in Information and Communication Technologies - ICT (Digital for Development).

Indicatively, services providers will have to demonstrate their technical capacity and experience in Cybersecurity, Establishing CSIRTs, Continental Level Surveys, Stakeholder Mobilisation, International Aid Project Management, Digital for Development.

The start of the contract is foreseen for May 2023 and for a duration of six months (4.5 months for the formulation team to do the surveys, develop the CSIRT model, an Aide-Mémoire as well as write the draft Technical and Financial Document – TFD, followed by a maximum of six weeks for the team leader after six weeks to finalise the TFD). The service provider must be available for the designated period and willing to intervene in Ethiopia and other African countries. The maximum budget available for this contract is estimated at 475 000 EUR (all taxes excluded).

The tender is launched under a suspensive clause, pending the validation of the budget by the Ministry of Foreign and European Affairs of the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg foreseen in the coming weeks.

Interested services providers are invited to submit sufficient documentation to respond to the selection criteria. The dossier, including the selection criteria and the application form, is available on request at the address given below.

The shortlist of candidates invited to submit a full offer will be established of a minimum three and maximum eight candidates evaluated as qualified and ranked, if necessary, against the selection criteria.
