TITLE: Renovation and upgrade of Emergency and ICU departments of Bolikhamxay Provincial Hospital (Works)

in the framework of Programme LAO/027 receiving financial support from the Governments of the Lao P.D.R. and the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg.

This notice of invitation is launched by and according to the procedures of the Luxembourg Agency for Development Cooperation (Lux-Development), on behalf of Programme LAO/027 receiving financial support from the Governments of Lao PDR and of the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg.

1. Identification and financing of the Projects/Programmes

- a) Title: LAO/027 (Lao-Luxembourg Health Sector Support Programme – Phase II)
- b) Source of financing: The Government of Lao PDR and Government of the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg as set out in the Protocol of Programme LAO/027 dated 03.07.2014.
- c) The financing is fully available and approved under Programme LAO/027 which will proceed with the payments.
- d) Status of financing: Approved.

2. Identification of the Contract

- a) Type of Contract: Works
- b) Object: Renovation and upgrade of Emergency and ICU departments of Bolikhamxay Provincial Hospital.
- c) Reference number: LAO/027•21 4225
- d) Number of lots: One.
- e) Grouping of lots: N/A
- f) Description: The works consists in the renovation and upgrade of the existing Emergency and Intensive Care Unit departments of Bolikhamxay provincial hospital. The single storey building, built 10 years ago, has an approximate surface of 500 sqm. The works will mainly consist of the removal of floor, of ceiling, of some of the interior brick walls, of electric fixtures and the construction and installation of new walls, floor (including terrazzo and vinyl floors), ceiling, electric and plumbing fixtures, air conditioning (split and cassette type), replacement of all doors and windows. Most of the columns and roof will be reused.

3. Eligibility and evaluation criteria

- a) Origin: No restriction.
- b) Eligibility: Companies satisfying the criteria included in the Statement of Good Standing and in the ethics clauses of the General Regulations.
- c) Evaluation: the lowest administratively and technically compliant tender will be granted the contract
- d) Variants: No variants will be considered.

4. Place and period of performance

- a) Location of the Programmes: Vientiane, Lao PDR.
- b) Place of performance of the Contract: Paksan, Bolikhamxay Province, Lao PDR.
- c) Performance period: 6 (six) months up to the Provisional Acceptance of the Works (excluding the warranty period), including a mobilization period up to 4 weeks.
- d) Validity period of Tenders: 90 days after the deadline for Submission of Tenders.

5. Definitions

An information meeting will take place before the site visit.

11. Complementary or additional services

This Contract does not include any complementary or additional Works other than those outlined in the Tender Dossier. In the event where complementary or additional Works would be required (initially not included), their value will be limited to a maximum of 50% of the amount of the initial Contract.
